Purpose of this Letter:

This ELF Letter of Agreement ("Letter") sets forth the terms and conditions under which the ELF will issue a legally binding guarantee to the Beneficiary through the Intermediary, representing funds legally held and available for transfer, subject to the terms below and governed by Australian law.

Definitions and Interpretation:

For the purposes of this Letter, the following terms shall have the meanings set forth: "ELF" means the Emitter of Legal Funds as identified herein; "Beneficiary" means the party entitled to receive the funds; "Intermediary" means the agent facilitating the transaction; "Guarantee" means the legally enforceable promise by the ELF to provide funds as described.

Terms and Conditions:

1. Guarantee Issuance

The ELF hereby guarantees the availability and forthcoming transfer of funds totaling AUD _____ to the Beneficiary upon satisfaction of the terms set forth herein.

2. Conditions Precedent

The issuance and execution of any transfer shall be subject to compliance with all required identification, verification, and anti-money laundering regulations applicable under Australian law and any related jurisdictions.

3. Transfer Method

Funds shall be transferred via mutually agreed banking channels or instruments acceptable to both ELF and Beneficiary,

with all costs borne as agreed in this Letter.

4. Confidentiality

All parties agree to maintain strict confidentiality regarding the terms, existence, and details of this Letter, except where disclosure is required by law or agreed in writing.

5. Representations and Warranties

Each party represents and warrants that they have full legal capacity and authority to enter this Letter and that no conflicts with other agreements exist.

6. Indemnity

Each party agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the others against any losses, claims, damages, or liabilities arising from breach of this Letter or applicable laws.

7. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This Letter shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Australia. Any disputes arising shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in the State of New South Wales.

8. Term and Termination

This Letter shall be effective upon execution and shall remain in force until the transfer is complete or terminated by mutual agreement or material breach by any party.

9. Notices

Any notices required or permitted under this Letter shall be in writing and delivered personally, by certified mail, or electronic means to the addresses specified herein.

10. Entire Agreement

This Letter constitutes the entire agreement between the parties regarding its subject matter and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, or representations.

11. Amendments

Any amendments or modifications must be in writing and signed by all parties.

12. Severability

If any provision is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

13. Force Majeure

No party shall be liable for any failure or delay due to causes beyond reasonable control, including acts of God, war, or government restrictions.

14. Counterparts

This Letter may be executed in counterparts, each deemed an original, all together constituting one document.

15. No Waiver

Failure to enforce any provision shall not constitute a waiver of any rights under this Letter.

16. Compliance with Laws

All parties shall comply with all applicable Australian laws, including financial, tax, and anti-corruption regulations.

17. Dispute Resolution

Prior to litigation, parties shall attempt to resolve disputes through mediation or arbitration under Australian rules.

18. Assignment

No party may assign rights or obligations without prior written consent.

19. Relationship of Parties

Nothing in this Letter shall create a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship.

20. Execution

The parties acknowledge having read, understood, and agreed to all terms herein and execute this Letter as their free act and deed.
